

According to the need, the estimate of gardening work will be established on the land and terrace provided by the beneficiary.**

**General terms & conditions for Establishment of floral garden in vacant land/ terrace available with households in urban areas and adjoining urban areas & government premises: -**

1. Agency/firm must submit proposal for all the components of **Establishment of floral garden in vacant land/ terrace available with households in urban areas and adjoining urban areas & government premises** together.
2. Two or more agency/firms of different name & of different registration no. etc. having are person as director or member of the board of director/proprietor/owner have restricted to submit this E.O.I/RFP proposal by the name of both or more firms.
3. E.O.I/RFP bid document can be sent by post/courier/or by hand. In case of delivery in person, the document may be dropped in the proposal box kept for this purpose at the Office of District of Horticulture Office, Jamtara at the address mentioned above.
4. The last date for submission of E.O.I/RFP document will be on or before **04:00 P.M.** on **10-12-2024** and the Technical Bid will be opened at **12:00 PM on 16-12-2024** before the duly constituted committee. The bidder or his authorized representative may remain present during the opening of such bid. E.O.I/RFP Bids received late after due date and time, will be summarily rejected. The District of Horticulture Office, Jamtara will be inno case responsible for late delivery or non-delivery of E.O.I/RFP Bid due to postal delay etc.
5. Contact no., e-mail and full address of the bidder must be clearly mentioned in E.O.I/RFP/RFP. proposal.
6. In the event of any complaint regarding after sales service and in case of supply of defective/substandard material, the selected firm shall have to rectify the defects within a period of 15 days. The firm must have a service centre with qualified technical staff in the state.
7. E.O.I/RFP/RFP proposal submitted without relevant papers/documents will be rejected.
8. The District of Horticulture Office, Jamtara is free to evolve strong punitive measure against erring companies to safeguard the interests of beneficiaries in order to ensure proper utilization of public funds.
9. Component material should be as per the quality specifications mentioned in Annexure-V of the proposal documents. Failure to supply as per the quality specifications shall result in for forfeiture of earnest money/security deposit, blacklisting and legal action against the agency/firm.
10. Bidders or their duly authorized representatives may be present at the time of opening the main envelope and the Technical Bid, the time and place for which is indicated in the E.O.I/RFP document.
11. All the E.O.I/RFP documents should be signed by the authorized person, carrying the

prescribed letter of authority and his full name and status should be indicated below his signature with the seal of agency/firms per Annexure-I. It is mandatory for bidder to mention serial number on each page of E.O.I/RFP document. The all pages of E.O.I/RFP Bid document must be signed by authorized person with stamp otherwise such E.O.I/RFP document will be summarily rejected.

12. Conditional E.O.I/RFP bid proposal will not be accepted.
13. Since the E.O.I/RFP has been invited for rate fixation, so the rate submitted by any firm found to be the lowest will be the final rate per unit of supply. However, another agency/firm can be empanelled for the items subject to agree to supply the items in the lowest fixed unit rate. All the selected agency/firms shall follow that lowest fixed rate, provided this rate per unit should not exceed the maximum permissible cost.
14. Supply order will be released to the enlisted agency/firm as per choice of the beneficiary by the competent authority. Payment to the supplier will be made by beneficiary/competent authority as per accordance of the government guidelines issued. No interest will be payable on the delayed payment by the competent authority.
15. No claim will be entertained afterwards for any increase in the market price or otherwise.
16. Participation in the E.O.I/RFP bid will automatically imply the acceptance, on part of the participating agency/firm of all the terms and conditions of this E.O.I/RFP/RFP
17. 18. The District evaluation/tender committee, reserves the right to verify, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above or to reject any or all the E.O.I/RFP/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or may terminate the E.O.I/RFP/RFP process midway without assigning any reason.
19. Binding Clause: All decisions taken by the District evaluation/tender committee regarding the processing of this E.O.I/RFP and award of empanelment shall be final and binding on all concerned parties.
20. Delivery: Executing agency must deliver the all materials at the site of beneficiary without any extra transportation charge in the state of Jharkhand.
21. Quantity: The physical target will be determined by the Government order time to time throughout the empanelment period. District Authority of Horticulture Department shall place the order only as per the actual requirements from time to time.
22. District Horticulture Officer, Jamtara reserves the right to reject/cancel the empanelment of agency/firm at any time if he/she is satisfied that it is desirable to do so in farmer's interest after giving an opportunity of hearing such an applicant. The decision of District of Horticulture Officer, Jamtara shall be final and binding.
23. Period of Validity of E.O.I/RFP Bids: The bid shall remain valid till completion of all contractual obligations.

24. Warranty: The successful bidder shall give a warranty pots and plastic items for any packaging defects up to delivery of the material at site. Bidder shall agree to replace or repair at his own cost, part or whole bag found defective after receipt of intimation within three days from the undersigned regarding the defects.
25. Resolution of Disputes: The matter regarding any dispute shall be sorted out at the level of the District Horticulture Officer, Jamtara. If the dispute persists to remain unresolved then it will be entertained, heard & finalized by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Cooperative, whose decision shall be binding and final upon both parties. Any legal dispute if arises, will be settled at Jamtara jurisdiction only.
26. Test certificate where applicable should be furnished and that can be verified from issuing agency. For testing of material, the fee shall be borne by the agency/firm as and when required.
27. All taxes applicable as per government norms.
28. Force Majeure: Neither party will be liable in respect of failure to fulfill its obligations, if the said failure is entirely due to Acts of God, Governmental restrictions or instructions, natural calamities or catastrophe, epidemics or disturbances in the country. The party affected by an event of Force Majeure will immediately notify the other party of such an event and will also notify the unaffected party on cessation of disability resulting from such Force Majeure act.
29. Time Schedule: The time period stipulated in the purchase order or letter of intent shall be deemed to be essence of the contract.
30. Agreement: The selected agency will have to enter in to an agreement with District Horticulture Officer, Jamtara. The copy to the agreement shall be made available to District Horticulture Officer, Jamtara to the selected agency and to be executed before assigning the supply work order.

**MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS: -**

The departmental evaluation/tender committee will evaluate the Technical Bid of the E.O.I/RFP received from bidder. Following documents are required for qualifying in Technical Bid, to be submitted along with PART-I Technical Bid otherwise the E.O.I/RFP proposal will be summarily rejected, in no case any documents will be accepted after opening of E.O.I/RFP/RFP

- i. The agency/firm should furnish a copy of G.S.T registration certificate.
- ii. The agency/firm should furnish a copy of income tax permanent account no. (PAN)
- iii. The last three years average annual turnover of the agency/firms must not be less than **Rs.10.00 lakhs**. Details of profit & loss accounts of audited balance sheets along with I.T return for the concerning financial years should be attached along with the E.O.I/RFP proposal.
- iv. Agency/firm applying for Establishment of floral garden in vacant land/ terrace available with households in urban areas and adjoining urban areas & government premises should have at least two years' experience in the Establishment of Gardening sector. Concerning work order/experience certificate should be attached with E.O.I/RFP proposal in support of experience.
